460 Security Forces Squadron (SpOC) (AFMC)

Lineage. Constituted as 860 Military Police Company (Aviation) on 21 Apr 1942. Activated on 3 May 1942. Redesignated as 860 Guard Squadron on 1 Aug 1942. Disbanded on 31 Mar 1944. Reconstituted, and redesignated as 460 Security Forces Squadron, 26 Apr 2001. Activated on 1 Oct 2001.

Assignments. Fourth Air Force, 3 May 1942-31 Mar 1944. 460 Support (later, 460 Missions Support) Group, 1 Oct 2001; Space Base Delta 2, 23 May 2022-.

Stations. Paine Field, WA, 3 May 1942-31 Mar 1944. Buckley AFB (later SFB), CO, 1 Oct 2001-.

Service Streamers. World War II: American Theater. Global War on Terrorism – Service (GWOT-S).

Campaign Streamers. None.

Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers. None.

Decorations. Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards: 1 Oct 2001-1 Oct 2002; 2 Oct 2002-2 Oct 2003.
