Redesignated as 21 Medical Group on 1 May 1992. Activated on 15 May 1992. Inactivated on 1 Oct 1998. Activated on 1 Oct 2003.

**Assignments.** 21 Fighter-Bomber Wing, 1 Jan 1953-8 Feb 1958. 21 Tactical Fighter Wing, 1 Jul 1958-16 Feb 1959. 21 Space Wing, 15 May 1992-1 Oct 1998. 21 Space Wing, 1 Oct 2003; Peterson-Schriever Garrison (later, Space Base Delta 1), 24 Jul 2020-.
