## **85 Fighter Group (AETC)**

Lineage. Established as 85 Bombardment Group (Light) on 13 Jan 1942. Activated on 10 Feb 1942. Redesignated as: 85 Bombardment Group (Dive) on 27 Jul 1942; 85 Fighter-Bomber Group on 15 Aug 1943. Disestablished on 1 May 1944. Reestablished, and redesignated 85 Tactical Fighter Training Wing, on 31 Jul 1985. Consolidated (29 Sep 1994) with Air Forces Iceland, which was established as Iceland Air Defense Force, and organized, on 1 Apr 1952. Redesignated as Air Forces Iceland on 1 Jan 1960. Inactivated on 31 May 1993. Redesignated as 85 Wing on 29 Sep 1994. Activated on 1 Oct 1994. Redesignated as 85 Group on 1 Jul 1995. Inactivated on 28 Jun 2006. Redesignated as 85 Fighter Group on 18 Ma 2024. Activated on 2 Jul 2024.
