Lineage. Established as 937 Troop Carrier Group, Heavy, and activated in the Reserve on 28 Dec 1962. Organized on 17 Jan 1963. Redesignated as: 937 Air Transport Group, Heavy on 1 Dec 1965; 937 Military Airlift Group on 1 Jan 1966. Inactivated on 20 May 1972. Redesignated as 937 Training Group on 31 Aug 2011. Activated on 15 Sep 2011. Inactivated on 20 Jan 2016. Activated on 30 Apr 2025.

Continental Air Command, 28 Dec 1962; 442 Troop Carrier Wing, 17 Jan 1963; 512 Troop Carrier (later, 512 Air Transport; 512 Military Airlift) Wing, 5 Feb 1965; 442 Military Airlift (later, 442 Tactical Airlift) Wing, 21 Apr 1971-20 May 1972. 37 Training Wing, 15 Sep 2011-20 Jan 2016. 37 Training Wing, 30 Apr 2025-.
