Reestablished, redesignated as 944 Support Group, and activated in the Reserve, on 1 Aug 1992. Redesignated as 944 Mission Support Group on 1 Oct 2002.

Assignments. 944 Reserve Air Depot Training Wing, 12 Oct 1951-11 Apr 1952. 944 Fighter Group (later, 944 Fighter Wing), 1 Aug 1992-.

Stations. Kelly AFB, TX, 12 Oct 1951-11 Apr 1952. Luke AFB, AZ, 1 Aug 1992-.
