Reestablished, redesignated as 944 Logistics Group, and activated in the Reserve, on 1 Aug 1992. Redesignated as 944 Maintenance Group on 1 Oct 2002. Inactivated on 1 Oct 2007. Activated on 1 Jul 2017.

Assignments. 944 Reserve Air Depot Training Wing, 12 Oct 1951-11 Apr 1952. 944 Fighter Group (later, 944 Fighter Wing), 1 Aug 1992-1 Oct 2007. 944 Fighter Wing, 1 Jul 2017-.
