



## United States Air Force **Lineage and Honors History**

### **Air Force Security Forces Center (AFMC)**

**Lineage.** Established as Air Force Office of Security Police and activated as a Separate Operating Agency on 1 Sep 1979. Status changed to a Field Operating Agency on 5 Feb 1991. Redesignated as Air Force Security Police Agency on 1 Aug 1991; Air Force Security Forces Center Agency, and status changed to a Direct Reporting Unit on 17 Mar 1997. Status changed to Field Operating Agency on 1 Oct 1998. Status changed from a Field Operating Agency to a subordinate establishment of Air Force Materiel Command on 1 Oct 2014.

**Assignments.** Hq, United States Air Force, 1 Sep 1979; Air Force Materiel Command, 1 Oct 2014; Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center, 6 Apr 2015-.

**Stations.** Kirtland AFB, NM, 1 Sep 1979; Lackland AFB, (later, Joint Base San Antonio-Lackland), TX, 1 Oct 1997-.

**Service Streamers.** None.

**Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers.** None.
