Redesignated as 1 Space Analysis Squadron and, concurrently, changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 24 Jun 2022. Redesignated as 1 Intelligence Analysis Squadron on 20 Dec 2024.
