2 Space Warning Squadron (SpOC)

Lineage. Constituted as 2 Space Communications Squadron on 1 May 1992. Activated on 15 May 1992. Redesignated as 2 Space Warning Squadron on 1 May 1993. Changed status from a unit of the United States Air Force armed force to a unit of the United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2021.

Assignments. 21 Operations Group, 15 May 1992; 21 Space Wing, 21 Jul 1995; 821 Space Group, 31 May 1996; 21 Operations Group, 11 May 1999; 460 Operations Group (later, Space Delta 4), 19 Aug 2004 -.

Stations. Buckley ANGB (later, AFB, SFB), CO, 15 May 1992-.

Service Streamers. Global War on Terrorism-Service (GWOT-S).
