Lineage. Constituted as 3 Space Communications Squadron on 1 May 1992. Activated on 15 May 1992. Inactivated on 1 Aug 2002. Redesignated as 3 Satellite Communications Squadron on 14 Mar 2022. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force, and activated on 24 Mar 2022.

Assignments. 21 Operations Group, 15 May 1992; 821 Space Group, 31 May 1996; 21 Operations Group, 29 May 2001-1 Aug 2002. Space Delta 4, 24 Mar 2022-.

Stations. Kapaun Adm Annex, Germany, 15 May 1992-1 Aug 2002. Buckley SFB, CO, 24 Mar 2022-.


