10 Space Warning Squadron (SpOC)

Lineage. Constituted as 10 Missile Warning Squadron on 10 Jul 1986. Activated on 1 Aug 1986.

Redesignated as 10 Space Warning Squadron on 15 May 1992. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2020.

Assignments. 1 Space Wing, 1 Aug 1986; 21 Operations Group, 15 May 1992; Space Delta 4, 24 Jul 2020-.

Stations. Cavalier AFS (later AS; SFS), ND, 1 Aug 1986-.

Service Streamers. Global War on Terrorism – Service (GWOT-S)
