13 Space Warning Squadron (SpOC)

Lineage. Constituted as 13 Missile Warning Squadron, and activated, on 1 Nov 1966. Organized on 1 Jan 1967. Redesignated as 13 Space Warning Squadron on 15 May 1992. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2020.

Assignments. Air Defense Command, 1 Nov 1966; 71 Missile Warning Wing, 1 Jan 1967; Fourteenth Aerospace Force, 30 Apr 1971; Alaskan ADCOM Region, 1 Oct 1976; 47 Air Division, 1 Dec 1979; 1 Space Wing, 1 May 1983; 21 Operations Group, 15 May 1992; Space Delta 4, 24 Jul 2020-.

Stations. Clear Missile Early Warning Station (later, Clear AFS; AS; SFS), AK, 1 Jan 1967-.
