21 Space Operations Squadron (SpOC)

Lineage. Constituted as 21 Space Operations Squadron on 10 Jul 1991. Activated on 1 Oct 1991. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2020.

Assignments. 2 Satellite Tracking (later, 750 Space) Group, 1 Oct 1991; 50 Operations Group, 7 Jun 1999; 50 Network Operations Group (later, Space Delta 6), 10 Mar 2004-.

Stations. Onizuka AFB (later, AS, AFS), CA, 1 Oct 1991; Vandenberg AFB (later SFB), CA, 29 Jul 2010-.

Service Streamers. Global War on Terrorism-Service (GWOT-S).

Campaign Streamers. None.

Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers. None.
