



# United States Space Force Lineage and Honors History

## 22 Space Operations Squadron (SpOC)

**Lineage.** Constituted as 22 Space Operations Squadron on 10 Jul 1991. Activated on 1 Oct 1991.

Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2020.

**Assignments.** 2 Satellite Tracking Group (later, 750 Space) Group, 1 Oct 1991; 50 Operations Group, 2 Jun 1999; 50 Network Operations Group (later, Space Delta 6), 10 Mar 2004-.

**Stations.** Falcon AFB (later, Shriever AFB, SFB), CO, 1 Oct 1991-.

**Service Streamers.** Global War on Terrorism – Service (GWOT-S)

**Campaign Streamers.** None.

**Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers.** None.

**Decorations.** Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards: 1 Sep 1993-31 Aug 1995; [2 Jun 1999]-30 Sep 2000; 1 Oct 2000-1 Oct 2001; [2] Oct 2001-1 Oct 2002; 2 Oct 2002-2 Oct 2003; 1 Oct 2007-30 Sep 2009; 1 Jan 2015- 31 Dec 2016.
