## **30 Operations Support Squadron (SSC)**

**Lineage.** Constituted as 30 Airdrome Squadron on 25 Jan 1943. Activated on 1 Feb 1943.

Redesignated as 30 Airdrome Squadron (Special) on 16 Apr 1943. Disbanded 1 Apr 1944.

Reconstituted, and redesignated as 30 Operations Support Squadron on 1 Nov 1991. Activated on 19 Nov 1991. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 7 May 2021.

**Assignments.** Second Air Force, 1 Feb 1943-1 Apr 1944. 30 Operations Group, 19 Nov 1991; Space Launch Delta 30, 7 May 2021-.

**Stations.** Kearney AAF, NE, 1 Feb 1943; Scott Field AAB, IL, 17 Aug 1943; Kearney AAB, NE, 3 Nov 1943-1 Apr 1944. Vandenberg AFB (later, SFB), 19 Nov 1991-.

**Service Streamers.** World War II American Theater.

**Campaign Streamers.** None.

**Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers.** None.
