392 Combat Training Squadron (STARCOM)

Lineage. Constituted as 592 Bombardment Squadron (Heavy) on 29 Jan 1943. Activated on 16 Feb 1943. Inactivated on 1 May 1944. Consolidated (19 Sep 1985) with the 392 Missile Training Squadron, which was constituted on 20 May 1957. Activated on 15 Sep 1957. Redesignated as 392 Missile Training Squadron (IRBM) on 1 Apr 1958. Discontinued, and inactivated, on 1 Feb 1963. Redesignated as: 92 Tactical Missile Squadron on 19 Sep 1985; 392 Space and Missile Training Squadron on 1 Jul 1993. Activated on 1 Jul 1993. Redesignated as 392 Training Squadron on 1 Apr 1994. Inactivated 1 Jul 2012. Redesignated as 392 Combat Training Squadron on 19 Aug 2021. Changed status from unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 23 Aug 2021. Activated 23 Aug 2021.


