



## United States Air Force **Lineage and Honors History**

### **460 Civil Engineer Squadron (SpOC) (AFMC)**

**Lineage.** Constituted as 460 Aviation Squadron on 19 Jan 1944. Activated on 7 Feb 1944. Inactivated on 20 Nov 1947. Disbanded on 2 Feb 1950. Reconstituted, and redesignated as 460 Civil Engineer Squadron on 26 Apr 2001. Activated on 1 Oct 2001.

**Assignments.** Ogden Air Service Command, 7 Feb 1944; Army Air Forces, Pacific Ocean Areas, 19 May 1945; Eighth Air Force, 15 Aug 1945; Pacific Air Service Command, 15 May 1946; 301 Fighter Wing, 15 Nov 1946; 22 Air Depot, 15 Dec 1946; 1 Air Division, 20 Feb-20 Nov 1947. 460 Support (later, Mission Support) Group, 1 Oct 2001; Space Base Delta 2, 23 May 2022-.

**Stations.** Hill Field, UT, 7 Feb 1944-31 Mar 1945; Ie Shima, 19 May 1945; Kadena AAB, Okinawa, 24 Dec 1945; Naha, Okinawa, 15 May 1946-20 Nov 1947. Buckley AFB (later, SFB), CO, 1 Oct 2001-.

**Service Streamers.** World War II: American Theater. Global War on Terrorism – Service (GWOT-S).

**Campaign Streamers.** *World War II:* Ryukyus.

**Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers.** None.

**Decorations.** Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards: 1 Oct 2001-1 Oct 2002; 2 Oct 2002-2 Oct 2003.
