7 Civil Engineer Squadron (AFGSC)

Lineage. Designated as Squadron C, 7 Airdrome Group on 3 Nov 1947.¹ Organized on 17 Nov 1947. Discontinued on 1 Aug 1948. Consolidated (3 Oct 1984) with 7 Installations Squadron, Bombardment Heavy, which was constituted on 20 Jul 1948. Activated on 1 Aug 1948. Redesignated as 7 Installations Squadron on 16 Mar 1950. Inactivated on 20 Jun 1953. Activated on 1 Dec 1957. Discontinued on 15 Mar 1960. Redesignated as 7 Civil Engineering Squadron on 29 Jan 1964. Organized on 1 Sep 1964. Inactivated on 30 Sep 1993. Activated on 1 Oct 1993. Redesignated as 7 Civil Engineer Squadron on 1 Mar 1994.

Assignments. 7 Airdrome Group, 17 Nov-1 Aug 1948.² 7 Air Base Group, 1 Aug 1948-20 Jun 1953. 7 Air Base (later, 7 Combat Support) Group, 1 Dec 1957-15 Mar 1960. 7 Combat Support (later, 7 Support) Group, 1 Sep 1964-30 Sep 1993. 7 Support (later, 7 Mission Support) Group, 1 Oct 1993-.

Stations. Fort Worth AAFld (later, Griffis AFB, Carswell AFB), TX, 17 Nov 1947-1 Aug 1948.³ Carswell AFB, TX, 1 Aug 1948-15 Mar 1960. Carswell AFB, TX, 1 Sep 1964-30 Sep 1993. Dyess AFB, TX, 1 Oct 1993-.

Service Streamers. Global War on Terrorism-Service (GWOT-S).

¹ Squadron C, 7 Airdrome Group was designated and organized under the Table of Distribution (T/D) and discontinued on 1 Aug 1948. T/D organizations are temporary. Why HAF took this action to consolidate a permanent organization with their temporary counterpart is unknown.

³ Squadron C, 7 Airdrome Group stationing period.
