Redesignated as: 16 Weather Squadron, Regional, on 25 Aug 1942; 16 Weather Squadron 17 Aug 1943. Inactivated on 18 Nov 1957. Activated on 8 Jul 1959. Inactivated on 1 Oct 1976. Activated on 18 Nov 2009.


