Lineage. Constituted as 25 Airdrome Squadron on 25 Jan 1943. Activated on 1 Feb 1943. Redesignated as 25 Airdrome Squadron, Special, on 16 Apr 1943. Inactivated on 21 Oct 1943. Disbanded on 1 Apr 1944. Reconstituted on 11 Sep 1946. Activated on 15 Oct 1946. Inactivated on 28 Jul 1948. Disbanded on 8 Oct 1948. Reconstituted, and redesignated, as 25 Operations Support Squadron, on 13 Feb 2018. Activated on 27 Feb 2018.

Assignments. Second Air Force, 1 Feb-21 Oct 1943. 24 Composite Wing, 15 Oct 1946-28 Jul 1948. 25 Attack Group (later, 25 Attack Wing), 27 Feb 2018-.

Stations. Topeka, KS, 1 Feb-21 Oct 1943. Coolidge Field (later Coolidge Air Base), Antigua, 15 Oct 1946-28 Jul 1948. Shaw AFB, SC, 27 Feb 2018-.
