## **28 Intelligence Squadron (AFRC)**

**Lineage.** Constituted as 28 Photo Lab, Bomb Group, Very Heavy, on 25 May 1944. Activated on 1 Aug 1944. Inactivated on 22 Feb 1946. Disbanded on 8 Oct 1948. Reconstituted, and consolidated (18 Sep 2014) with 28 Intelligence Squadron, which was constituted as 28 Reconnaissance Technical Squadron on 3 Mar 1950. Activated on 1 May 1950. Inactivated 15 Apr 1955. Redesignated as 28 Intelligence Squadron on 19 Mar 2014. Activated on 17 Apr 2014.

**Assignments.** 501 Bombardment Group, 1 Aug 1944-22 Feb 1946. 28 Strategic Reconnaissance Wing, 1 May 1950-15 Apr 1955. 655 Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Group, 17 Apr 2014; 755 Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Group, 15 Jan 2023-.

**Stations.** Dalhart AAF, TX, 1 Aug 1944; Harvard AAF, NE, 23 Aug 1944; Fort Lawton, WA, 10-17 Mar 1945; Hawaii, 25 Mar 1945; Tinian, c. Apr 1945; Northwest Field, Guam, c. 14 Apr 1945-22 Feb 1946. Rapid City (later, Ellsworth) AFB, SD, 1 May 1950-15 Apr 1955. Hurlburt Field, FL, 17 Apr 2014-.
