### 31 Logistics Readiness Squadron (USAFE)

**Lineage.** Designated as Supply Squadron, 31 Maintenance and Supply Group on 6 Nov 1947.

Organized on 20 Nov 1947. Discontinued on [22] Aug 1948.<sup>1</sup> Consolidated (8 Feb 1988) with 31 Supply Squadron, Fighter Jet which was constituted on 15 Jun 1948. Activated on 22 Aug 1948.

Redesignated as 31 Supply Squadron on 20 Jan 1950. Inactivated on 1 Jul 1952. Activated on 25 Sep 1957. Inactivated on 1 Jan 1959. Activated on 9 Jun 1967. Organized on 15 Jul 1967.

Inactivated on 1 Apr 1994. Activated on 1 Apr 1994. Redesignated as 31 Logistics Readiness Squadron on 2 Aug 2002.

**Assignments.** 31 Maintenance and Supply, 20 Nov 1947-22 Aug 1948;<sup>2</sup> 31 Maintenance and Supply Group, 22 Aug 1948; 31 Air Base Group, 1 Feb 1951-1 Jul 1952. Pacific Air Forces, 9 Jun 1967; 31 Tactical Fighter (later, 31 Tactical Training; 31 Tactical Fighter; 31 Fighter) Wing, 15 Jul 1967; 31 Logistics Group, 1 Nov 1991-1 Apr 1994. 31 Logistics (later, 31 Maintenance) Group, 1 Apr 1994; 31 Mission Support Group, 2 Aug 2002-.

**Stations.** Turner Fld (later, AFB), GA, 20 Nov 1947-22 Aug 1948;<sup>3</sup> Turner AFB, GA, 22 Aug 1948-1 Jul 1952. Tuy Hoa AB, South Vietnam, 15 Jul 1967-15 Oct 1970; Homestead AFB, FL, 15 Oct 1970-1 Apr 1994. Aviano AB, Italy, 1 Apr 1994-.

<sup>1</sup> Supply Squadron, 31 Maintenance and Supply Group was designated and organized under the Table of Distribution (T/D) and discontinued on 25 Aug 1948. T/D organizations are temporary. Why HAF took this action to consolidate a permanent organization with their temporary counterpart is unknown. Additionally, their periods of activation overlapped making continuous lineage confusing. To communicate the overlapped periods, brackets were used to mitigate the presentation of overlapped activation periods.
