Lineage. Constituted as 35 Aviation Depot Squadron on 5 Dec 1956. Activated on 1 Jan 1957. Redesignated as 35 Munitions Maintenance Squadron on 1 Jul 1960. Discontinued, and inactivated on 25 Jun 1966. Activated on 1 Oct 1971. Inactivated on 1 Oct 1978. Redesignated as 35 Munitions Squadron on 12 Dec 2024. Activated on 17 Jun 2025.

Assignments. 810 Air Base Group, 1 Jan 1957; 95 Combat Support Group, 1 Jan 1959 (attached to 95 Bombardment Wing, 17-30 Jun 1960); 95 Bombardment Wing, 1 Jul 1960-25 Jun 1966. 35 Tactical Fighter Wing, 1 Oct 1971-1 Oct 1978. 35 Maintenance Group, 17 Jun 2025-.


