Lineage. Constituted as 310 Airdrome Squadron on 1 Apr 1943. Activated on 5 Apr 1943. Redesignated as 43d Airdrome Squadron (Special) on 14 Jun 1943. Disbanded on 1 Apr 1944. Reconstituted, redesignated as 43 Operations Support Squadron, and activated, on 1 Jun 1992. Inactivated on 1 Oct 1996. Activated on 1 Apr 1997.

Assignments. 2 Air Force, 5 Apr 1943-1 Apr 1944. 43 Operations Group, 1 Jun 1992; 43 Air Refueling Group, 1 Jul 1994-1 Oct 1996. 43 Operations (later, 43 Airlift; 43 Air Mobility Operations) Group, 1 Apr 1997-.
