**Lineage.** Constituted as 44 Maintenance Squadron on 20 Dec 1950. Activated on 2 Jan 1951.

Redesignated as 44 Field Maintenance Squadron on 16 Jun 1952. Discontinued on 15 Jun 1960.

Inactivated on 22 Oct 1984. Redesignated as 44 Maintenance Squadron on 7 Jan 2010.

Activated on 1 Feb 2010.

**Assignments.** 44 Maintenance and Supply Group, 2 Jan 1951; 44 Bombardment Group, 10 Feb 1951; 44 Bombardment Wing, 16 Jun 1952-15 Jun 1960. 44 Fighter Group, 1 Feb 2010-.

**Stations.** March AFB, CA, 2 Jan 1951; Lake Charles Muni Airport (later, Lake Charles AFB; Chennault AFB), LA, 1 Aug 1951 (deployed at Sidi Slimane, French Morocco, 17 Jan-22 Feb 1953; 11 Apr-22 Jun 1954)-15 Jun 1960. Holloman AFB, NM, 1 Feb 2010; Tyndall AFB, FL 30 Apr 2014; Eglin AFB, FL, 18 Jun 2020; Tyndall AFB, FL, 1 Apr 2023-.
