### **316 Civil Engineer Squadron (AFDW)**

**Lineage.** Designated as Squadron C, 316 Airdrome Group, and organized on 15 Aug 1947. Discontinued on 25 Aug 1948. Consolidated (3 Oct 1984) with 316 Installations Squadron, Troop Carrier, Medium, which was constituted on 23 Jun 1948. Activated on 23 Aug 1948. Inactivated on 20 Oct 1949. Redesignated: 316 Civil Engineering Squadron on 3 Oct 1984; 316 Civil Engineer Squadron on 21 Jun 2006. Activated on 22 Jun 2006. Inactivated on 1 Oct 2010. Activated on 25 Jun 2020.

**Assignments.** 316 Airdrome Group, 15 Aug 1947-25 Aug 1948. 316 Air Base Group, 23 Aug 1948-20 Oct 1949. 316 Mission Support Group, 22 Jun 2006-1 Oct 2010. 316 Mission Support Group, 25 Jun 2020-.
