Lineage. Constituted as 377 Service Squadron on 11 Sep 1942. Activated on 16 Sep 1942. Redesignated as 377 Air Service Squadron on c. 1944. Inactivated on 5 Feb 1946. Disbanded on 8 Oct 1948. Reconstituted, and redesignated as 377 Test Support Squadron on 4 Oct 2022. Activated on 1 Nov 2022.

Assignments. 68 Service Group, 16 Sep 1942; 51 Service Group, 26 Dec 1943; AAF, India-Burma Theater, 30 Dec 1945-5 Feb 1946. 377 Test and Evaluation Group, 1 Nov 2022-.
