Lineage. Constituted as 379 Bombardment Squadron (Medium) on 28 Jan 1942. Activated on 15 Mar 1942. Resdesignated as 379 Bombardment Squadron, Medium, on 28 Apr 1944. Inactivated on 12 Sep 1945. Redesignated as 379 Bombardment Squadron, Light, on 11 Mar 1947. Activated in the Reserve on 11 Jun 1947. Inactivated on 27 Jun 1949. Redesignated as 379 Bombardment Squadron, Medium, on 15 Mar 1952. Activated on 28 Mar 1952. Discontinued, and inactivated, on 25 Mar 1965. Redesignated as 379 Space Range Squadron on 14 Feb 2012. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Apr 2012.
