Lineage. Designated as 2114 communications Squadron, and activated, on 1 Feb 1979. Redesignated as: 2114 Information Systems Squadron on 1 Aug 1984; 2114 Communications Squadron on 1 Nov 1986; 432 Communications Squadron on 31 May 1991. Inactivated on 1 Oct 1994. Redesignated as 432 Expeditionary Communications Squadron, converted to a provisional unit, and assigned to PACAF to activate or inactivate any time after 16 Jan 2002. Withdrawn from assignment to PACAF for use as provisional unit and redesignated as 432 Communications Squadron on 16 Feb 2007. Activated on 14 Mar 2025
