### **436 Aerial Port Squadron (AMC)**

**Lineage.** Constituted as 436 Aerial Port, and activated, on 27 Dec 1965. Organized on 8 Jan 1966.

**Stations.** Dover AFB, DE, 1 Dec 1991-.

**Service Streamers.** Global War on Terrorism-Service (GWOT-S).
