Lineage. Constituted as 436 Installations Squadron on 8 Sep 1950. Activated in the Reserve on 16 Oct 1950. Ordered to Active Service on 1 Apr 1951. Inactivated on 16 Apr 1951. Activated in the Reserve on 18 May 1955. Inactivated on 15 May 1958. Redesignated as 436 Civil Engineering Squadron, and activated, on 27 Dec 1965. Organized on 8 Jan 1966. Redesignated as 436 Civil Engineer Squadron on 1 Mar 1994.
