472 Electronic Combat Squadron (ACC)

Lineage. Constituted as 472 Bombardment Squadron (Medium) on 9 Jul 1942. Activated on 16 Jul 1942. Disbanded on 1 May 1944. Reconstituted, and consolidated (19 Sep 1985) with 472 Fighter-Bomber Squadron, which was constituted, and activated on 1 Apr 1954. Inactivated on 16 Nov 1957. Redesignated as: 472 Tactical Electronic Warfare Squadron on 19 Sep 1985; 472 Electronic Combat Squadron on 21 Mar 2025. Activated on 1 May 2025.

Assignments. 334 Bomb Group, 16 Jul 1942-1 May 1944. 439 Fighter-Bomber Group, 1 Apr 1954-16 Nov 1957. 319 Operations Group, 1 May 2025-.
