Redesignated as 607 Air Materiel Squadron c. 22 Mar 1945. Inactivated on 10 Dec 1945.

Activated on 14 Jan 1947. Inactivated on 24 Aug 1948. Disbanded on 8 Oct 1948.

Reconstituted, and redesignated as 607 Materiel Maintenance Squadron, on 5 May 1997.

Activated on 7 May 1997.
