Redesignated as 55 Air Police Squadron, Strategic Reconnaissance on 1 Jul 1949. Inactivated on 14 Oct 1949. Redesignated as 55 Air Police on 27 Oct 1950. Activated on 1 Nov 1950. Inactivated on 16 Oct 1952. Redesignated as 55 Security Police Squadron on 12 Oct 1984. Activated on 1 Mar 1986. Redesignated as 55 Security Forces Squadron on 1 Jul 1997.

Assignments. 55 Air Base Group, 19 Jun 1948-14 Oct 1949. 55 Air Base Group, 1 Nov 1950-16 Oct 1952. 55 Combat Support (later, 55 Support; 55 Mission Support) Group, 1 Mar 1986-.

Stations. Topeka (later, Forbes) AFB, KS, 19 Jul 1948-14 Oct 1949; Ramey AFB, Puerto Rico, 1 Nov 1952-16 Oct 1952. Offutt AFB, NE, 1 Mar 1986-.


