## 57 Fighter Squadron (AETC)

Lineage. Constituted as 57 Pursuit Squadron (Interceptor) on 20 Nov 1940. Activated on 15 Jan 1941. Redesignated as 57 Fighter Squadron, Single Engine on 15 May 1942. Disbanded on 1 May 1944. Reconstituted, and redesignated as 57 Fighter Squadron (All Weather) on 24 Mar 1947. Activated in the Reserves 15 May 1947. Inactivated on 27 Jun 1949. Redesignated as 57 Fighter-Interceptor Squadron on 11 Feb 1953. Activated on 27 Mar 1953. Redesignated as 57 Fighter Squadron on 31 May 1993. Inactivated on 1 Mar 1995. Activated on 2 Jul 2024.
