Redesignated as 60 Airdrome Squadron (Special) on 16 Apr 1943. Disbanded on 1 Apr 1944.

Reconstituted, and redesignated as 60 Operations Support Squadron, on 28 Oct 1991. Activated on 1 Nov 1991.
