Lineage. Constituted as 1000 Signal Company, Service Group on 28 Aug 1942. Activated on 15 Sep 1942. Inactivated on 6 Apr 1945. Redesignated as 98 Cyberspace Operations Squadron on 2 Dec 2025. Activated on 2 Jan 2026.

Assignments. 96 Service Group, Mobile, 15 Sep 1942; XII Air Force Service Command, c. 4 Feb 1944; 15 Air Force, further assigned to XV Air Force Service Command, 22 May 1944-6 Apr 1945. 960 Cyberspace Operations Group, 2 Jan 2026-.

Stations. Tuskegee, AL, 15 Sep 1942; Selfridge Fld, MI, c. 3 Apr 1943; Oscoda, MI, c. 10 Jun 1943-3 Jan 1944. Montecorvino, Italy, c. 1 Mar 1944; Ramitelli, Italy, 29 May 1944-6 Apr 1945. Joint Base San Antonio-Lackland, TX, 2 Jan 2026-.
