Redesignated as 346 Strategic Reconnaissance Squadron, Heavy, and activated, on 1 Jan 1953. Redesignated as 346 Bombardment Squadron, Heavy on 1 Oct 1955. Inactivated on 31 Mar 1974. Redesignated as 346 Test and Evaluation Squadron on 1 Jun 1993. Activated on 15 Jun 1993. Inactivated on 21 Sep 1995. Redesignated as 346 Test Squadron on 17 Jul 2000. Activated on 1 Aug 2000. Redesignated as 346 Cyberspace Test and Evaluation Squadron on 28 Jan 2025,
