Lineage. Constituted, activated and organized as 625 Military Airlift Support Squadron, 8 Jan 1966. Inactivated on 1 Aug 1983. Consolidated (1 Jun 1992) with the HQ, 625 Military Airlift Support Group which was constituted on 1 Jul 1983. Activated on 1 Aug 1983. Redesignated as: 625 Airlift Support Squadron on 1 Jun 1992; 625 Air Mobility Support Squadron, 1 Apr 1994; 725 Air Mobility Squadron, 15 Mar 2001.


