916 Aircraft Maintenance Squadron (AFRC)

Lineage. Constituted as 916 Air Engineering Squadron on 8 May 1945. Activated on 1 Jun 1945. Inactivated on 7 Nov 1945. Disbanded on 8 Oct 1948. Reconstituted, redesignated as 916 Aircraft Generation Squadron, and activated in the Reserve on 1 Apr 1995. Redesignated as 916 Aircraft Maintenance Squadron on 1 Oct 2002.

Assignments. 498 Air Service Group, 1 Jun-7 Nov 1945. 916 Logistics (later, 916 Maintenance) Group, 1 Apr 1995-.

Stations. Mannheim/Sandhofen, Germany, 1 Jun-6 Aug 1945; Drew Field, FL, 25 Aug-7 Nov 1945. Seymour Johnson AFB, NC, 1 Apr 1995-.

Service Streamers. World War II: European-African-Middle Eastern Theater.

Campaign Streamers. None.

Armed Forces Expeditionary Streamers. None.
