Consolidated (12 Apr 2007) with 916 Communications Flight, which was constituted, and activated on 3 May 1966. Organized in the Reserve on 1 Jun 1966. Inactivated on 8 Jul 1972. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Oct 1994. Redesignated as 916 Communications Squadron on 12 May 2007. Inactivated on 1 Jan 2012. Redesignated as 916 Communications Flight on 8 May 2024. Activated on 16 Aug 2024.
