### **919 Special Operations Communications Squadron (AFRC)**

**Lineage.** Constituted as 919 Communications Flight on 13 September 1981. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Oct 1981. Redesignated as: 919 Information Systems Squadron on 10 Apr 1985; 919 Communications Squadron on 1 Feb 1987; 919 Special Operations Communications Flight on 1 Aug 1992; 919 Communications Flight on 1 Oct 1994. Inactivated on 1 Apr 1997. Redesignated as 919 Communications Squadron on 19 Apr 2005. Activated in the Reserve on 19 May 2005. Redesignated as 919 Special Operations Communications Squadron on 30 Sep 2013.

**Assignments.** 919 Combat Support Squadron, 1 Oct 1981; 919 Special Operations Group, 10 Apr 1985; 919 Support Group, 1 Aug 1992; 919 Operations Group, 15 Oct 1992; 919 Support Group, 1 Oct 1994-1 Apr 1997. 919 Mission Support (later, Special Operations Mission Support) Group, 19 May 2005-.
