Lineage. Constituted as 919 Tactical Dispensary, and activated, on 15 Jan 1963. Organized in the Reserve on 11 Feb 1963. Discontinued, and inactivated, on 15 Dec 1965. Activated in the Reserve on 30 Jul 1971. Redesignated as: 919 Tactical Clinic on 1 Apr 1973; 919 Tactical Hospital on 1 Oct 1989; 919 Medical Squadron on 1 Nov 1990; 919 Special Operations Medical Squadron on 30 Sep 2013.

Assignments. 919 Troop Carrier Group, 11 Feb 1963-15 Dec 1965. 919 Tactical Airlift (later, Special Operations) Group, 30 Jul 1971; 919 Medical Group, 1 Aug 1992; 919 Special Operations Wing, 1 Oct 1994-.
