Redesignated as: 919 Security Police Flight on 15 Aug 1988; 919 Security Police Squadron on 1 Oct 1992; 919 Security Forces Squadron on 1 Jul 1997; 919 Special Operations Security Forces Squadron on 30 Sep 2013.

**Assignments.** 919 Combat Support (later, Mission Support) Squadron, 30 Jul 1971; 919 Support (later, Mission Support; Special Operations Mission Support) Group, 1 Aug 1992-.
