Lineage. Constituted as 934 Civil Engineering Flight on 19 Jun 1969. Activated in the Reserve on 25 Oct 1969. Redesignated as 934 Civil Engineering Squadron on 15 Nov 1978; 934 Civil Engineer Squadron on 1 Mar 1994.

Assignments. 934 Tactical Airlift (later, 934 Airlift) Group, 25 Oct 1969; 934 Support (later, 934 Mission Support) Group, 1 Aug 1992-.

Stations. Minneapolis-St Paul Intl Aprt (later, Minneapolis-St Paul IAP-Air Reserve Station), MN, 25 Oct 1969-.
