Redesignated as: 934 Information Systems Squadron on 10 Apr 1985; 934 Communications Squadron on 1 Feb 1987; 934 Communications Flight on 1 Aug 1992; 934 Communications Squadron on 1 Jan 2012.

Assignments. 934 Troop Carrier (later, 934 Tactical Airlift) Group, 1 Jun 1966; 934 Combat Support Squadron, 1 Nov 1975; 934 Tactical Airlift (later, 934 Airlift) Group, 10 Apr 1985; 934 Support (later, 934 Mission Support) Group, 1 Aug 1992-.

Stations. Minneapolis-St Paul IAP (later, Minneapolis-St Paul IAP-ARS), MN, 1 Jun 1966-.
