Redesignated as: 934 Morale, Welfare, Recreation and Services Flight on 1 Jan 1993; 934 Services Flight on 1 Jan 1994; 934 Services Squadron on 15 Sep 1997; 934 Force Support Squadron on 1 Dec 2010.
