Lineage. Constituted as 934 Weapons System Security Flight on 21 May 1971. Activated in the Reserve on 29 Jun 1971. Redesignated as: 934 Security Police Flight on 15 Aug 1988; 934 Security Police Squadron on 1 Oct 1992; 934 Security Forces Squadron on 1 Jul 1997.

Assignments. 934 Combat Support (later, 934 Mission Support) Squadron, 29 Jun 1971; 934 Support (later, 934 Mission Support) Group, 1 Aug 1992-.

Stations. Minneapolis-St Paul IAP (later, Minneapolis-St Paul IAP-Air Reserve Station), MN, 29 Jun 1971-.
