Reestablished, and redesignated as 77 Tactical Intelligence Wing on 31 Jul 1985) and the 77 Air Base Wing (established as 2852 Air Base Wing, and organized, on 1 Aug 1953. Redesignated as: 652 Support Group on 1 Oct 1992; 652 Air Base Group on 1 Oct 1993; 77 Air Base Wing, 1 Oct 1994. Inactivated on 13 Jul 2001.) consolidated (23 Jun 2006) with the 77 Aeronautical Systems Wing (established as Agile Combat Support Systems Wing on 23 Nov 2004. Activated on 18 Jan 2005. Redesignated as 77 Aeronautical Systems Wing on 14 Jul 2006. Inactivated on 30 Jun 2010). Consolidated organization retained designation 77 Aeronautical Systems Wing. Redesignated as 77 Intelligence Wing on 1 Jul 2025. Activated on 31 Jul 2025. Assignments.
